Policy Statement

During the time a student is academically suspended or dismissed from ECU, course work earned at another regionally-accredited college or university will be considered for transfer credit when the student returns to ECU. Students are responsible for requesting that an official transcript of any transfer course work be sent to the ECU Office of Admissions when they apply for readmission to ECU. Students should consult with their advisor or college for the applicability of course work taken at another institution to their degree program at ECU.
